



SMHR FOUNDERS MEDAL 2017

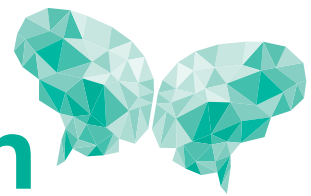

Details of Award

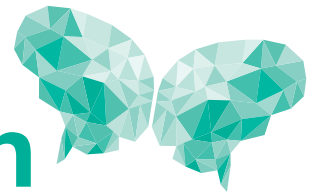
The award is a medal, certificate and payment of the 2017 conference registration fees.

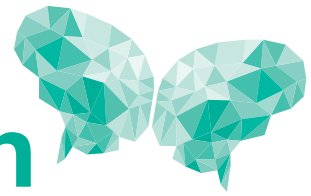

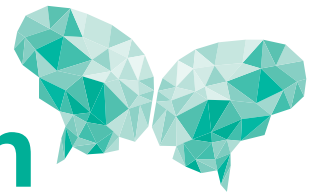
